30 MINUTES OF GUIDED PRAYER

5 MINUTES

Spend time praising God. What are the names and attributes of God that are special to you? Read the following verses and use them as praise for who the Lord is.

Psalm 15:1-2 Psalm 98:1-4 Psalm 103:1-5 Psalm 145

5 MINUTES

Thank God for the first 20 Years of Rolling Hills:

His provision of places to meet and additional campuses that have been launched - Nolensville, Nashville, Columbia, Haywood Hills, and Online.

Launching Justice and Mercy International 15 years ago and for the ability to serve and love the people of Moldova and Brazil.

All who have professed their salvation through believer's baptism. Are there specific names you can offer up in praise?

15 MINUTES

Spend time praying for the Five Mission Components of the NEXT Campaign. Pray that God will grow us closer to Him through 100% participation of our church family.

1. The NEXT 20 Years

God put us in Nashville, where people are coming from all over the United States. Williamson County alone is reported to double in the next 20 years. As a church, we've grown by 30% over the past year, which means we will double in the next three years. People keep coming, and we need more space for people to hear and grow in Christ. Pray for God's people to be generous.

2. The NEXT Generation

We have hopes and dreams for our children that they will always have a place where they feel safe, take the next steps in their faith journey, and experience joy in community with others. Our goal is simple: to continue to create pathways for the Next Generation to know and follow Jesus. Pray for all of those in our family ministry environments - preschool through high school. Thank the Lord for our amazing Core Team who faithfully serve every week and for new Core Team members to be added. Pray for the NEXT generation who will be the leaders of the Church.

3. The NEXT Ministry

In Matthew 22, Jesus reminded His disciples of the first commandment to love the Lord your God with all of your heart, all of your soul, and all of your mind. But He also says, "the second is like it, you shall love your neighbor as yourself." The Rolling Hills Community Center at Haywood Hills will allow our church family to love on our neighbors who call South Nashville home. This Community Center will become the hub for our Do Good Local missions. Pray for Roberto Pagán, who is the Director of the Community Center. Pray for the groundwork that's being done to identify ministry needs. Pray that those who come to the Community Center will be helped physically, emotionally, and spiritually.

4. The NEXT Mission

Scripture is clear that God calls his people to take the Gospel to the ends of the earth. Together, we have worked in Moldova and the Amazon to "Uphold the cause of the poor and the oppressed," as Psalm 82:3 says. Vulnerable children have hope and a future through child sponsorship; at-risk teens have protection from trafficking through transitional living homes, and jungle pastors have training and support to take the Good News to remote villages. We are now broadening our ministry into Italy to explore how we may have a greater impact throughout Europe. Please pray for us to reach the next child, the next teen, the next pastor, and beyond in the name of Christ. For the poor, orphaned, and forgotten around the world.

5. The NEXT One

As we anticipate the physical spaces that will be created and the additional ministries and discipleship opportunities that will take place, we don't want to lose sight of the individuals whose lives will change. Pray for the NEXT one who will come to know Christ as a result of these spaces, ministries, and opportunities. Who are you praying for to come to know Christ? Who needs to take the step of baptism to declare their faith in Christ? Pray for each person to have a next step in their spiritual journey.

End by praying Ephesians 3:20-21

Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us, to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, for ever and ever! Amen.
